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THE NEW RAYO[®]METER PLUS

One for all situations

The editorial in the latest issue of Rayonex feedback made it clear: Our highly technological world is vulnerable. Power outages, natural disasters and infrastructure disruptions are no longer theoretical scenarios, but real challenges. These developments also require a rethink in the field of healthcare. The question of how therapeutic concepts and devices can remain reliable even under exceptional conditions is therefore becoming increasingly important.

Against this background, one aspect that was already mentioned in the editorial comes into sharp focus: The need for solutions that function independently of external power supplies while remaining true to the principles of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt. This is precisely where the Rayo[®]meter plus comes in. As a logical further development within the Rayonex system, it combines proven biophysical principles

with the aim of being a reliable companion even in challenging situations.

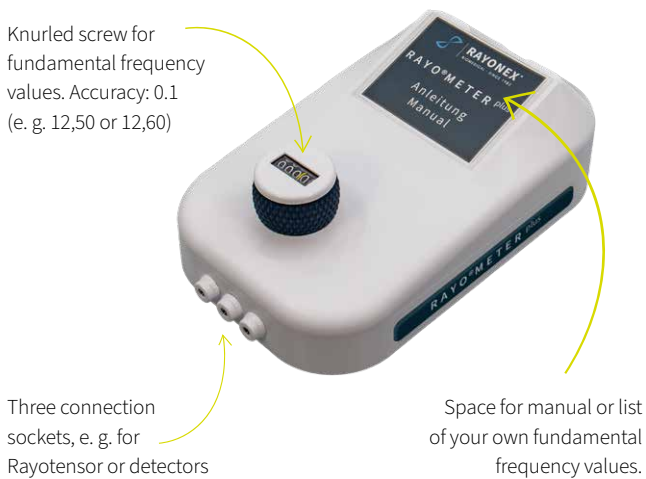
Barely six months after its introduction in the editorial of Rayonex feedback no. 05, the time had come: The first Rayo[®]meter plus ready for series production was completed in January 2026. The combination of over 40 years of experience, quickly realisable injection moulding tools and the consistent use of 3D-printed components made this exceptionally short development time possible.

The new Rayo[®]meter plus is a useful addition to the range of Bioresonance devices according to Paul Schmidt. As a powerful yet attractively priced entry-level device, it provides easy access to the world of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt.

The particular strength of the Rayo®meter plus lies in its complete independence from external power supplies. This means it can be used safely in any situation – even during a complete power failure. At the same time, it provides valuable therapeutic support for the steadily growing number of electro-sensitive people. The fact that a Bioresonance device according to Paul Schmidt can also be used effectively without an external energy source is also proven by the results of an ongoing doctoral thesis, which explains the functioning of the dipole antennas integrated in the device from a mathematical, physical and electrodynamic point of view.



The new Rayo®meter plus also impresses with its particularly easy handling. The desired fundamental frequency value is taken either from the book on Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt or from the overview included in the scope of delivery and then set using the knurled screw. After connecting one of the various available detectors, the corresponding frequencies can be applied to humans or animals for harmonisation.

When entering the fundamental frequency values, please note that only two-digit values are permitted on the display. For example, the value 10,00 on the left of the image is set correctly, while the display on the

right of the image is not permitted. An exception is the value 100,00, which functionally corresponds to the value 0,00.



Although the Rayo®meter plus shares the manual setting of fundamental frequency values with earlier devices, it differs from its predecessors in one crucial respect: the ability to harmonise three central RAH programs – vitalisation, detoxification (basic program) and stress reduction.

To use one of these three integrated RAH programs, the fundamental frequency value is set to 10,00. The desired RAH program can then be selected using the selector switch on the back of the device.



The name Rayo®meter plus was chosen in honour of Paul Schmidt and Paul Heimes. Paul Schmidt always pursued the goal of establishing a bioresonance device as a measuring instrument – comparable to a voltmeter, barometer, thermometer or hygrometer. This gave rise to the name Rayometer. Paul Heimes, in turn, developed the Rayometer PS 10 and the Rayometer Digital between 1990 and 1992, of which well over 30,000 devices were manufactured in total. With the new Rayo®meter plus, Rayonex Biomedical is not only reflecting on its roots and the vision of its pioneers, but is also expanding this foundation with the latest findings in Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt.

The high demand already shows that the Rayo®meter plus has successfully integrated itself into the product portfolio of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt as a fully-fledged device. Of particular interest, of course, is the assessment of long-time users of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt. We are therefore all the more pleased to be able to present you with the **first experience report** from a pioneer of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt, Mr Hussmann, in this issue. Rayo®meter plus – an initial case report

I am holding the new Rayo®meter plus in my hands for the first time. My thoughts immediately turn to Paul Schmidt and Paul Heimes, who developed the Rayometer PS 10 and later the Rayometer Digital in his workshop in Lennestadt-Langenei in the early 1990s.

Now we have the Rayo®meter plus: A mechanically operated, power-independent device that was developed at the request of our Japanese friends. It has been brought up to date in terms of technology and design, features a modern look and has three connection sockets. I am particularly impressed by the precise adjustment knob, which allows fundamental frequency values to be set easily and accurately – a crucial factor in determining fundamental values. I think it is great that the Rayo®meter plus has three central RAH programs integrated. Many ‘old hands’ have not yet made the switch to the RAH system for various reasons. This now offers them an easy way to get started. The vitalisation, detoxification and stress reduction programs also cover areas that almost every user needs.

In conversations, I repeatedly heard that experienced users felt that the fundamental frequency values were not sufficiently taken into account. With the Rayo®meter plus, a modern therapy device is now available that is based on proven technology and at the same time offers new possibilities – without the need for a power connection. It is also noteworthy that the third generation of the Heimes family was involved in the development: Fynn Heimes, son of Dietmar Heimes and grandson of Paul Heimes, played a key role in designing the device.

The Rayo®meter plus works with the same dipole antennas as the Rayocomp PS 10, thus consistently relying on the proven principle of frequency generation. For me, the fine adjustment is the heart of the device – ideal for anyone who wants to delve deeply into fundamental value measurement according to Paul Schmidt. Of course, it is also possible to work with a Rayotensor or single-handed rod. (Adolf Hußmann)



LITTLE STEPS, BIG PROGRESS

A Boy's journey with Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt –
Gentle support for more calm and balance in the life of a child with autism.

With great joy and a touch of excitement, we would like to share our very first heartfelt project in this issue – the therapeutic support of a nine-year-old boy. This project is especially close to our hearts, as it not only demonstrates the possibilities of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt, but also reveals how much hope, patience, and trust are woven into every individual therapeutic journey.

In the previous issue of Rayonex feedback, we explained the characteristics of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and discussed the opportunities that Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt (BaPS) offers as an energetic testing and therapy system. Bioresonance is not a promise of healing – rather, it is a gentle method of supporting the body on an energetic level and helping it regain its natural balance. Now, for the first time, we would like to present the case of a child whom we were privileged to accompany over a period of six months, from the first cautious steps to tangible progress that deeply touched all of us.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This case concerns a nine-year-old boy diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). Due to limitations in social interaction and communication, he was unable to attend a regular school for an extended period and was cared for at home. It is therefore all the more wonderful that he has recently been able to attend school

again, three days per week, marking an important step toward independence and social integration. At present, he speaks only a few words ('yes', 'no', 'Mama', 'Papa', 'doei'), yet he increasingly understands more complex instructions and responds clearly when spoken to. His mother reports that he appears more alert, attentive, and interested in his surroundings. He has faced a challenging medical history: Diaphragmatic surgery, nearly one year of hospitalisation, and two years of oxygen therapy have shaped his early years. In addition, he suffers from epilepsy, which is being treated with medication. Because of his medical condition, he follows a gluten- and dairy-free diet.

THE THERAPY WITH BIORESONANCE ACCORDING TO PAUL SCHMIDT

For about six months, the boy has been receiving energetic therapy (Bioresonance therapy) based on the system developed by Paul Schmidt. The sessions take place two to three times a week, mostly at night, without any pressure or active participation required. This ensures that the application remains completely calm and stress-free for the child. Every six weeks, international Rayonex trainer Raymond Dros performs a Rayoscan® test to individually adjust the therapy parameters. The results show continuous improvement in several physiological areas, particularly in the systems related to detoxification, the nervous system, and immune balance.



Support

Due to their financial situation, the family was accepted into the **Rayonex® Foundation's support program**, which allowed the therapy to continue uninterrupted and ensured the boy's positive development.

The support includes:

- Provision of a Rayocomp PS 10 basic device for home use
- Ongoing therapeutic supervision and regular testing by Raymond Dros

FINDINGS FROM THE RAYOSCAN® ANALYSES

The initial test results showed significant stress levels in several areas:

- **Cell and tissue physiology:** indications of limited detoxification capacity
- **Nervous system:** second-highest priority – clear reactive patterns
- **Pathogens (immune system):** above-average stress, evident imbalance

Over the course of therapy, these burdens were gradually reduced. The test results demonstrate increasing harmonisation of physiological systems and improved regulatory capacity of the body. However, the most meaningful progress cannot be captured by numbers alone, it reveals itself in everyday life, in the small moments.

The boy's mother reports with great joy the following noticeable improvements:

- ✓ More calmness and relaxation in daily life
- ✓ Improved concentration
- ✓ Greater openness in social interaction, reintegration into school routine
- ✓ More stable sleep rhythm
- ✓ Increased eye contact and attentiveness
- ✓ Overall more harmonious behaviour

These developments clearly show that he responds very positively to the combined approach of energetic support, tailored nutrition, and educational guidance.

OUTLOOK

In the coming weeks, an EEG examination is planned to medically document potential neurological improvements. In parallel, language, attention, and social behaviour will continue to be observed. The results so far are encouraging – the boy responds very positively to this gentle, non-invasive form of therapy. His mother expresses deep gratitude for the visible progress her son has made and for the support he has received. Based on the positive experiences of recent months, it has become clear that the therapy is truly beneficial for the boy. Therefore, his mother has decided to rent a Rayocomp in the future to continue the treatment independently and on a long-term basis.

CONCLUSION

The story of this boy highlights the value of a holistic and individualised approach for children with autism. The combination of Bioresonance therapy, targeted nutritional support, and a stable, loving family environment has led to a noticeable improvement in his quality of life. For us, this project is not only a therapeutic success but also a heartfelt mission, a testament to how much positive change is possible when dedication, compassion, and modern energetic methods work hand in hand. SUPPORTING PEOPLE WITH DIABETES USING BAPS

Understanding the body before symptoms arise – preventive support for people with diabetes.

At Rayonex Biomedical, we are frequently asked whether it makes sense to support patients with type 1 diabetes using Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt. To answer this question, it is helpful to first understand the fundamental differences between the two main forms of diabetes mellitus.

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN TYPE 1 AND TYPE 2 DIABETES

The key difference lies in the cause of the disease:

Type 1 diabetes: Here, the immune system destroys the insulin-producing cells in the pancreas. It is an autoimmune disease that leads to an absolute insulin deficiency. Those affected are permanently dependent on insulin.

Type 2 diabetes: Insulin continues to be produced, but the body's cells are less sensitive to it – this is referred to as insulin resistance. This form is often exacerbated by factors such as lack of exercise, obesity, and genetic predisposition. The result: In many cases, type 2 diabetes can be better controlled because lifestyle and metabolic regulation play a major role. Appropriate measures can improve insulin utilisation and, in many cases, even reduce the daily insulin dose.

BIORESONANCE AS A SUPPORTIVE MEASURE

Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt offers various possibilities for supporting the organism on an energetic level.

Our Test Protocol RAH 51.40 can be a valuable aid in this regard. It lists all relevant RAH programs, describes the connections to the disease, names the affected organ systems and supports the creation of an individual therapy program. Alternatively, the Compact Program can also be used.

A targeted analysis with the Rayoscan® also makes it possible to detect energetic stresses or imbalances at an early stage that may be associated with typical

symptoms of diabetes. This provides a holistic overview of the energetic state of the body – a crucial step in preventive, complementary health care.





KEEPING AN EYE ON THE LONG-TERM EFFECTS OF DIABETES

Diabetes mellitus can lead to various complications over time – especially if accompanying or secondary diseases are not detected in time. These include, among others:

- **Eye damage (diabetic retinopathy):** Damage to the fine blood vessels of the retina, which can lead to impaired vision and even blindness.
- **Nerve damage (diabetic neuropathy):** For example, abnormal sensations, digestive problems, bladder dysfunction or potency problems.
- **Cardiovascular diseases:** Increased risk of heart attack and stroke.
- **Kidney damage (diabetic nephropathy):** Impaired kidney function, up to and including kidney failure.

- **Diabetic foot:** Poor wound healing on the feet, which can lead to chronic ulcers or, in extreme cases, amputations.
- **Other autoimmune diseases:** For example, an increased risk of coeliac disease or hypothyroidism.
- **Mental health issues:** Depression, anxiety or eating disorders often occur alongside diabetes.

This is precisely where the Rayoscan® shows its strength: It can provide indications of energetic imbalances long before clinical symptoms appear. This allows the organism to be monitored at an early stage in order to prevent accompanying symptoms as effectively as possible.

In our view, it makes sense to regularly check what is going on energetically in the body in the case of chronic diseases such as diabetes mellitus. Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt is understood as a complementary approach to conventional medical care – in particular, to identify possible stresses at an early stage and balance them energetically.

After all, what could be more helpful than preventively checking a sick person's energy to protect them as best as possible from possible secondary diseases?

GLIOBLASTOMA

A case report by Bianca Kessel

Some client stories stay with us for a lifetime. This was the case with the client who visited my practice shortly after being diagnosed with glioblastoma. Glioblastoma is a very aggressive brain tumour, which usually comes as a shock to those affected and their families.

She came to me immediately after the tumour had been surgically removed. She was facing a three-week stay in a clinic with intensive combination therapy consisting of daily chemotherapy and radiation treatment.

I tested her using the Test Protocol from the C-Module 'Glioblastoma'. I saved the appropriate RAH programs on a Green-Card for the client. Fortunately, she already owned a Rayocomp PS 10, which she could take with her to the clinic. In addition, I gave her Rayobase® to support her acid-base balance, Rayoflora® to stabilise her intestinal flora, and an appropriate micronutrient preparation.

My recommendation was to treat herself every other day in the clinic using the Green-Card and to swing in her morning urine using the Protection Cup in order to specifically regulate her personal reaction to the chemo.

Shortly after her stay in hospital, she returned to my practice, and I was very surprised by her condition. The strain of the last few weeks was hardly noticeable on the outside. She reported that she had tolerated the treatments surprisingly well. She had only occasionally suffered from sore gums and had struggled

with some constipation in between. However, she had not experienced any severe nausea or exhaustion, and overall, she had felt well.

Today, six years after her diagnosis, her health remains stable. (Text: Bianca Kessel)

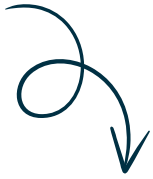

NEW APPROACHES IN TESTING: SACHETS INSTEAD OF AMPOULES

New insights into the use of Rayocomp devices,
particularly when testing our nutritional supplements.



The system of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt is an open system that is continuously being developed. Ongoing research and practical experience are constantly yielding new and valuable insights for our daily work.

NEW SCIENTIFIC FINDINGS

Current studies in the field of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt have shown that **plastics do not constitute a barrier to the transmission of frequency spectra between Rayocomp devices and substances.**

This finding has a direct impact on practical application, especially when testing our nutritional supplements.

What does this mean in concrete terms for working with the Rayocomp device?

As you know, presentations and training sessions are an excellent way to demonstrate how our nutritional supplements can help compensate for energetic deficits in areas such as acid-base balance, dysbiosis or vitamin and mineral deficiencies.

The procedure remains basically the same:

1. The corresponding energetically disturbed RAH program is set on the Rayocomp.
2. The Rayotensor shows a linear movement.
3. An ampoule containing the appropriate nutritional supplement is placed in the Protection Cup.
4. If the product has an energetic supportive effect, the linear movement of the Rayotensor changes to a rotation.

This process has been known for years as the ‘ampoule test’, and for a long time a free set of ampoules was available on request from Rayonex Biomedical.

New evidence from research

Thanks to Dietmar Heimes' scientific research on dipole antenna systems and the behaviour of fundamental frequency values (Pilsen), practical improvements have now been made for our daily use. Whereas it was previously recommended to use only glass containers for energetic transfers, today the sachets of our nutritional supplements can also be used directly. Instead of the special ampoule sets that were previously required, the sachets from Rayobase®, Rayovita® and Rayoflora® now serve as a practical alternative.

In practice, this means that the sachets can be placed directly on the Protection Cup without the need for decanting or additional ampoules. The testing process is thus faster and more convenient, while maintaining the same high energetic quality of transmission.

These new findings lead to a noticeable increase in efficiency and user-friendliness in our daily work with the Rayocomp. We are delighted that continuous research in the field of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt is constantly refining our practical work without losing any precision or significance.

everyday therapeutic practice. Concrete case studies clearly demonstrated how Bioresonance can be successfully combined with homeopathy, dietary adjustments and the evaluation of blood counts. The focus was on transparent documentation and careful monitoring of progress.

Katrin Blümchen clearly explained the importance of multimodal therapy concepts using the practical example of spondylosis in dogs. She showed how different physiotherapeutic measures can be combined effectively and how Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt (BaPS) effectively complements this holistic approach.

The high practical relevance of her presentation was particularly impressive: She brought along dog spines with various changes, giving participants a tangible experience. Ms Blümchen's intimate connection to the vertebral bodies she brought with her (e. g. the spine of a French bulldog) caused a few laughs.

The programme was supplemented by informative contributions from the companies MycoVital and cd-Vet. Ms Friedrich from MycoVital shared her extensive expertise and provided practical insights into the versatile applications of medicinal mushrooms in veterinary medicine. Mr Dingmann from cdVet gave an insight into the company's philosophy and showed how natural products and energetic diagnostics can work together to provide sustainable support for metabolism, the immune system and vitality.

During the breaks, numerous participants took advantage of the companies' information stands to find out more about the products.

Kathrin Häringer's presentation provided a 'fragrant' conclusion to the day. With a practical application of essential oils, participants were able to experience the activating effect of orange oil on their own bodies. Further examples from her practice demonstrated the safe use of essential oils on animals and their beneficial combination with Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt.

The Day of the Veterinarians 2025 once again impressively demonstrated the value of personal exchange and collaborative learning. High-quality professional input, practical content and a warm atmosphere made the event an all-round success. We would like to express our special thanks to all the lecturers for their knowledge and inspiring contributions, as well as to all participants for their great interest in the event. Strengthen regulation – Stabilise milieu – Promote quality of life

My professional exchange with GladiatorPLUS began in 2005. What started with Manuel Kirsch's interest in Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt and my fascination with GladiatorPLUS developed over the years into a trusting collaboration. Today, I am delighted to make this growing connection accessible to therapists and dedicated animal owners alike in a joint project in the veterinary field. The Day of the Veterinarians 2024 provided an opportunity to further deepen this long-standing exchange and give it a new, concrete direction. In an impressive and at the same time very practical presentation, Manuel Kirsch, Managing Director of GladiatorPLUS, and Tanja Ostwald, animal naturopath and experienced therapeutic companion,

conveyed the company's environmental philosophy and holistic therapy concept. The open, appreciative professional dialogue on that day laid the foundation for the current collaboration between Rayonex Biomedical and GladiatorPLUS, which will officially begin in 2026. GladiatorPLUS stands for a holistic approach that considers the body's environment to be an important factor for well-being, balance and vitality. Liquid milieu feeding is based on many years of development work, proven natural substances and high bioavailability. In daily practice, it is repeatedly demonstrated how well this form of support is accepted by the animal organism – often accompanied by visible changes in behaviour, vitality and well-being.



This project shows how trust, experience and a shared approach can lead to a collaboration that not only takes a holistic view of animal health, but also embodies it with responsibility, respect and genuine solidarity.

Back in 2025, I published my first report on the combination of GladiatorPLUS and Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt in my book 'Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt in the veterinary field'. In the chapter on feed testing, Tanja Ostwald describes the therapeutic journey of the 19-year-old stallion El Setan. This case study impressively demonstrated how both approaches can complement each other in a meaningful way when regulation and adapted feeding are considered together. On this basis, a one-year long-term observation study involving a total of 60 animals (48 horses, 12 dogs) was launched in close cooperation with the Therapy and Consulting Centre in Lennestadt. The animals were regularly monitored by the GladiatorPLUS team, video recordings were made, consultations were held and developments were observed attentively and with great care.



The focus was on the combination of Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt and GladiatorPLUS milieu feeding. The results were consistently positive and

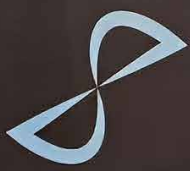
impressively confirmed the interaction of both methods: Bioresonance can provide indications of energetic imbalances, while GladiatorPLUS milieu feeding is considered part of daily feeding and provides targeted nutrition. A particularly valuable component of the therapy concept was the accompanying home therapy. The application of Bioresonance in the familiar home environment proved to be an ideal complement to continuously support regeneration and recovery processes. The peace, security and elimination of stress factors enabled many animals to better accept and implement the therapeutic impulses.

A key result of this collaboration is the special edition **Rayocomp PS 10-GladiatorPLUS**. The device has been equipped with nine specially developed therapy programs that have proven themselves in application monitoring. They provide energetic support for the metabolism and intestines, the musculoskeletal system, and the heart and respiratory tract, and can be started directly on the device using a simple sequence of buttons. This makes the combination of bioresonance and milieu feeding suitable for everyday use, practical and easy to implement for pet owners.

The results of the long-term observation and the overall concept of the cooperation will be published in the current year via the social media channels of GladiatorPLUS and Rayonex Biomedical. The aim is to present this proven combination in a transparent manner and to establish it in the long term both in animal therapy practice and in the home environment of animals as part of a forward-looking and responsible approach to animal husbandry and feeding.

Inspiration, exchange and new perspectives for Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt

The Rayonex Information Days in Cologne, Apeldoorn (NL), Soltau and Grassau in February and March 2026 were very well attended. The event kicked off on 21st February 2026 at the Radisson Blu Hotel in Cologne, attracting numerous users and interested parties from across the German-speaking world. The location impressed with its inspiring atmosphere, intensive technical discussions and a programme that successfully combined practical relevance and scientific classification.

It was clear from the beginning that the participants had come not only to acquire knowledge, but above all to exchange ideas in person. The direct dialogue between lecturers, experienced users and newcomers was repeatedly highlighted as one of the greatest added values of the day and characterised the open, collegial atmosphere of the whole event.

SCIENTIFIC INSIGHTS AND TECHNICAL BACKGROUND

Dietmar Heimes kicked off the technical programme with a presentation that vividly combined theory and practice. He clearly explained how modern Bioresonance devices according to Paul Schmidt work – from the Mini-Rayonex 5G to the Rayocomp PS 10 to the Rayocomp PS 1000 polar 4.0 and the Rayo®meter plus. Spontaneous questions from the audience showed the great interest in the technical context. Particular attention was paid to the insights into his ongoing doctoral thesis on the development of biomedical dipole antennas, which made the scientific background tangible and deepened understanding of the technology.

PLANT POWER MEETS FREQUENCY MEDICINE

Vicky Hollerbaum demonstrated how naturopathy and modern Bioresonance can complement each other in her practical lecture on phytotherapy. Numerous examples clearly showed how medicinal plants can support therapeutic processes as regulating stimulants – both in human and in the veterinary field. The new RAH module on phytotherapy aroused particular interest, as it opens up new ways of looking at test results in a more differentiated manner and designing therapies on a more individual basis. Many participants took away concrete ideas for their daily work.

A HOLISTIC VIEW OF THE LIVING ENVIRONMENT

Building biologist and architect Jörg Günter drew attention to the human environment. He vividly demonstrated the seemingly unnoticed influence that building biology factors such as electrosmog, pollutants and geopathic influences – especially in the sleeping area – can have on the body's regulatory abilities. The presentation of the future training programme to become a certified building biology consultant made it clear how these aspects can be systematically recorded and integrated into therapeutic work in a practical manner. Here, too, there were already several expressions of interest from the audience in participating in the training programme.



The information day was a very well-rounded event with a great atmosphere. There were excellent specialist presentations, and I find it particularly impressive that Rayonex is always striving to make the system even more user-friendly while ensuring that quality remains high through training and further education.

NEW DIAGNOSTIC POSSIBILITIES

The presentation by Gudrun Bunkenburg, who gave a user-friendly introduction to the new and individual ITP Scan in the Rayoscan® Human, was also followed with great interest. The possibility of creating individual Test Protocols and adapting them to one's own working methods was met with visible enthusiasm and provided many participants with concrete ideas for use in their own practice.



ENTHUSIASM, ENJOYMENT AND A LOOK INTO THE FUTURE

In addition to the technical content, the culinary concept was also widely praised: The healthy, rich and excellently coordinated catering provided the ideal basis for a concentrated and at the same time enjoyable event day.

A particular highlight was the announcement of RAI – Rayonex Artificial Intelligence. The presentation of this development step by Dietmar Heimes in his closing lecture was met with great enthusiasm and once again demonstrated the continuous advancement of Rayonex Biomedical and Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt.

The Information Days 2026 clearly demonstrated how dynamic the user community is – characterised by a thirst for knowledge, openness and the common goal of continuously developing therapeutic possibilities. The continuation of the event series is firmly planned. (Text: Claudia Brill)



VICKY HOLLERBAUM

An interview on the topic of 'Phytotherapy & Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt'



Vicky Hollerbaum is an animal naturopath with particular expertise in the field of phytotherapy. In her work, she combines naturopathic knowledge with coaching approaches and also runs the 'Kraftpferd' shop, where she offers high-quality herbal products. Her focus is on cause-oriented treatment, especially for stress-related or nervous disorders in animals. With her expertise in phytotherapy, she provided significant support in the creation of our RAH module Phytotherapy and is also happy to assist users with advice and support.

Claudia Brill: It is great that we can take some time today, Vicky. Let's get started right away: How did you actually come across Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt?

Vicky Hollerbaum: I knew right from the start that I wanted to use bioresonance in my horse practice. I had already had positive experiences with it in my early 20s through my alternative practitioner and knew that I definitely wanted to integrate this method into my work. While searching for a suitable option in the veterinary field, I came across Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt.

I attended the user seminar in Lennestadt, got a device and was immediately impressed. Since then, the Rayocomp PS 10 has become an indispensable part of my daily practice.



Claudia Brill: What particularly convinced you about this method, especially in comparison to other holistic methods?

Vicky Hollerbaum: The reactions of my own horses was the deciding factor. I tested the devices first and noticed differences immediately: With the Rayo-comp PS 10, I achieved visible, verifiable results that matched the symptoms of my horses. No other test device could keep up. The system also fits in very well with my way of working.

Right from the start, I needed a flexible, logically structured system that could be easily combined with phytotherapy, acupuncture, homeopathy and other methods. Rayonex also impressed me because the company pursues a sustainable, scientifically based approach – this gives me security and confidence in my practice.

Claudia Brill: What role does energetic work play in your everyday practice today?

Vicky Hollerbaum: A very big one. Although I mainly work with animals, changes in animals automatically affect their environment, including humans. Energy work creates impulses that often have a deeper effect than purely material therapies. I like to compare it to a stone falling into water: The resulting waves have an effect far beyond the actual trigger.

Claudia Brill: Let's move on to phytotherapy, your area of expertise. What makes working with plants so valuable to you?

Vicky Hollerbaum: Plants are one of the most primitive and simplest methods of therapy. They have accompanied humans and animals since time immemorial and have a profound influence on the body, mind and soul. Animals have always intuitively recognised what is good for them – often plants or certain places. This empirical knowledge ultimately forms the basis of our modern medicine.



Claudia Brill: How does energetic testing and harmonisation differ from classical phytotherapy?

Vicky Hollerbaum: Not that much, essentially. Both approaches set something in motion – in different ways. Classical phytotherapy works through ingredients, essential oils and the metabolism. Energetic work uses frequencies and oscillations that awaken a kind of memory of health and vitality in the cells. So, it is always about setting something in motion – either materially or energetically.

Claudia Brill: Why is it important to consider plants not only in terms of their material properties, but also in terms of their energetic properties?

Vicky Hollerbaum: Every plant has its own signature and aura. It can help us to accompany transformation processes, provide energy and support the body, mind and soul. I often use plants as constitutional remedies – they work on a psychosomatic level and accompany the organism through difficult phases.

Claudia Brill: Your test set forms the basis for the new phytotherapy module. In which areas has it proven itself?

Vicky Hollerbaum: It arose out of practical necessity: I wanted to identify synergies between plants and apply them specifically to certain symptoms. Over the years, the test set has evolved and is now valued by many colleagues because it is individually tailored and very practical.

Claudia Brill: How do phytotherapy and Bioresonance according to Paul Schmidt (BaPS) complement each other professionally?

Vicky Hollerbaum: BaPS provides the initial step: It helps to identify causes and stimulate regulation. Phytotherapy then continues to work on a material and energetic level, stabilising the organism and providing lasting support for self-healing. Together, these two methods bring long-term stability.

Claudia Brill: You have already had experience with the new energetic module RAH Phytotherapy – what did you notice?

Vicky Hollerbaum: The immediate reactions are particularly impressive. I used the frequency of nettle on my mare: She urinated during the treatment and searched for the plants in the paddock – an immediate regulatory process. Cats also reacted very calmly to valerian, hops and lemon balm on New Year's Eve. I myself could feel the different effects of marshmallow root and rosemary – the module shows very clearly how plant frequencies affect the body.

Claudia Brill: How do you like testing with the new ITP Scan in the Rayoscan® module?

Vicky Hollerbaum: The Rayoscan® is very informative. It shows the most relevant plants in descending order and allows for quick prioritisation. This way, I can immediately see which organ systems need special support and can efficiently classify the test results.



Claudia Brill: Are there any differences between humans and animals?

Vicky Hollerbaum: Basically, medicinal plants have a very similar effect on both. Differences tend to arise on an individual basis, depending on metabolism, lifestyle or regulatory speed.

Claudia Brill: For which indications is the phytotherapy module particularly suitable?

Vicky Hollerbaum: It is suitable for sensitive groups – small children, elderly people or cats – and especially for psychosomatic issues. In the case of overstimulated, exhausted or unstable organisms, energetic phytotherapy can gently help to restore movement and order to the system.

Claudia Brill: You provided technical support in putting together the module. What was particularly important to you in this regard?

Vicky Hollerbaum: I wanted to integrate traditional native medicinal plants, but also special plants from Ayurvedic medicine and other regions in order to raise awareness of their potential in the Western world. This creates a wide range of therapeutic options.

Claudia Brill: What feedback do you get from pet owners and users?

Vicky Hollerbaum: The response has been very positive. Owners appreciate that plants are tested and recommended directly, and the animals respond promptly and reliably. The combination of Bioresonance and phytotherapy in particular is perceived as practical and comprehensible.

Claudia Brill: Thank you very much, Vicky, for the detailed insights!

English name: Ginger

Botanical name: Zingiber officinale

Family: Zingiberaceae

Origin: South and Southeast Asia

Part of the plant used: Rhizome

Character/quality: Pungent, strongly warming, activating, stimulates digestion; promotes the flow of bodily fluids and invigorates

Main effects (traditional & phytotherapeutic): Warming, anti-inflammatory, immune-stimulating, antispasmodic, promotes blood circulation, analgesic, antiemetic

Classification in the phytotherapy module: If ginger is displayed as linear, this may indicate imbalances in the following areas: Immune system | Respiratory tract | Vascular system | Digestive organs | Musculoskeletal system | Psyche

Energetic classification: Earth (root/rhizome), fire (spiciness, heat)

Classic forms of application: Fresh, high-quality rhizomes or peeled dried root pieces in the form of: Tea, inhalation & steam inhalation, room fragrancng, poultices & wraps, baths & washes

An outstanding and familiar root will be the focus of phytotherapy in 2026, as the Study Circle for the History of Medicinal Plant Science and the Society for Phytotherapy have named ginger the medicinal plant of the year 2026.

This award comes at the beginning of the year, which is fitting, as ginger is particularly popular in many households during the cold season. Whether as an Ayurvedic pick-me-up drink or as a shot, this intensely spicy-tasting root is much more than just a kitchen spice. Ginger has been valued for generations for its immune-boosting properties. Despite extensive scientific research, its many active ingredients have not yet been fully deciphered.



Body: Gingerols and essential oils have antiviral, anti-sclerotic, anti-inflammatory, immune-stimulating, antispasmodic, circulation-promoting and pain-relieving effects, among other things by inhibiting COX-2. Bitter compounds promote saliva and gastric juice production, stimulate digestion and thus accelerate gastric emptying. Ginger is recognised as an antiemetic for travel, pregnancy and chemotherapy-induced nausea. In empirical medicine, it is used for cramps, migraines, menstrual pain, sensitivity to cold, joint problems and colds; antiparasitic effects have also been described.

Spirit: As a warming, pungent plant, ginger symbolises drive and assertiveness (Mars principle). It can help with lethargy, inner coldness and a lack of courage, but should be used sparingly in cases of nervousness.

Regulation / energy balance: In TCM (Traditional Chinese Medicine), ginger strengthens the immune system in cases of cold-related weakness, warms the lungs, stomach and spleen, and dispels mucus. In Ayurvedic teachings, it is considered activating, especially for the solar plexus centre, and has a balancing effect on Vāta and Kapha disorders. Caution is advised in cases of pronounced Yin deficiency.

Due to its circulation-promoting and blood-thinning effects, caution should be exercised when taking anti-coagulant medication at the same time. Ginger should be used with caution in cases of acute inflammation, bleeding, high fever or severe heat sensation.

Ginger is considered to be well researched in moderate amounts during pregnancy and breastfeeding. In cats, ginger should only be used energetically.

My name is **Jan Bjerke** and my first contact with the Rayonex system was in 2023 through my good friend Dr Alexander Melnyk from Ukraine. He told me about his experiences with the system and the results he had achieved. After some time I decided to order my first Rayonex device, the Rayocomp PS 10 light, which I later upgraded to be able to use the RAH programs

(Module M10). Having shared my own experiences and results with friends and acquaintances, I thought that this should be brought out to therapists or other interested parties in Norway.

On 01.10.2024 I then became the distributor in Norway and sold my first two Rayocomp PS 10 devices that same year. Especially well received is the possibility of renting, as users can access the system without making any major investments.

Additionally, visiting therapists and holding demonstrations – especially with the Rayoscan® – has also proven to be successful. 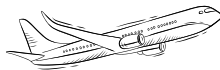
